DATA PROTECTION DECLARATION

Data categories/types of data

For the application by means of an application form, the data provided in the application documents are processed and stored.

Purpose of data processing

We process your personal data for the purpose of carrying out the selection and assessment process as well as – if awarded – for processing the IV-STEM-scholarship for high-potentials from Ukraine, for documentation purposes as well as for the fulfilment of reporting obligations and for public relations purposes.

Legal basis for processing data

The legal basis for processing your data in the course of the application and – if awarded – your use of an IV-STEM-scholarship for high-potentials from Ukraine awarded by the Federation of Austrian Industries is the performance of a contract. Further processing for documentation and public relations work and information for members and sponsors also constitutes a legitimate interest (Art. 6 par. 1 b GDPR).

Categories of recipients

The recipients of your personal data are the members of the jury.

In addition, we would like to point out that the following types of data may be made available on an IV website or published in publicly accessible reports: First names, last names, academic titles, gender, origin and target institution, if applicable, as well as title, description, duration and further information on the funded project.

Storage period of your data

Your data is stored as long as it is necessary or legally required for processing the scholarship, for documentation purposes or for reporting obligations to the public administration.



Information about automated decision-making

We do not carry out automated decision-making, including profiling, in accordance with Art. 22 (1) and (4) GDPR.

Your rights

You have the following rights:

- Right of access to the personal data concerned (Art. 15 GDPR).
- Right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR)
- Right to erasure (Art. 17 GDPR), insofar as this does not conflict with any statutory retention obligations
- Right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR)
- Right to object to processing (Art. 21 GDPR)
- Right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR)
- Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR): In Austria this is the data protection authority.
